Dear Judge Dippell:

On April 1, 2026, and in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8), Liberty initiated a new case with an ER designation and provided a revised tariff sheet (12th revised tariff sheet no. 17q) with a proposed effective date of June 1, 2026.

On April 30, 2026, Liberty, the Commission's Staff, and the Missouri Energy Consumers Group filed a Global Stipulation and Agreement that agreed the current period FAR for the Accumulation Period ending February 2026 and the Recovery Period ending November 2026 shall be \$20,704,202 instead of the \$33,958,307 set forth in the Company's direct testimony. This agreement was approved by Commission order on May 20, 2026.

Pursuant to the Commission-approved settlement, a substitute FAC tariff sheet is being submitted at this time. As a substitute, it continues to bear an issue date of April 1, 2026, and a requested effective date of June 1, 2026.

Dear Judge Dippell:

In accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8), Liberty is initiating a new case with an ER designation, and I am providing herewith to the Commission for filing, in electronic form, the FAC Direct Testimony of Monica K. Gloodt and the 12th revised tariff sheet no. 17q. This revised tariff sheet is dated today, with a proposed effective date of June 1, 2026. One testimony attachment contains confidential information, and a confidential designation cover page is included.

The FAC rate reflects the actual energy costs incurred by Liberty on behalf of its Missouri customers. The current period Fuel Adjustment Rate (“FAR”) for the Accumulation Period ending February 2026 and the Recovery Period ending November 2026 is \$33,958,307. For a Missouri residential customer using 1,000 kWh per month, the electric bill will increase by approximately \$14.81 per month over the six-month period of June 2026 through November 2026.

Additionally, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090(9), Liberty is initiating a new case with an EO designation, and I am providing herewith to the Commission for filing, in electronic form, the FAC True-Up Direct Testimony of Monica K. Gloodt and the additional information required by the Commission’s Rule.
