MOTION TO CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and moves for the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") to cancel Convergia, Inc.'s ("Convergia") Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services within the state of Missouri and states:

1. On February 27, 2003, in Commission File No. XA-2003-0246, the Commission granted Convergia a Certificate of Service Authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services within Missouri. On this date, the Commission also approved the accompanying tariff (Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 1).

2. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications Certificate of Service Authority pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

3. Multiple departments within the Commission, including the Staff Counsel's Office, have attempted to contact Convergia regarding the company's failure to pay the annual assessment for fiscal year 2026.¹ Despite this, Convergia has not made payment

arrangements. The requirement to pay the Commission assessment is identified in Section 386.370.3, RSMo and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.012(2)(A).

4. In light of the fact that Convergia has failed to pay the Commission assessment fees for fiscal year 2026, it is not legally, financially, or technically qualified to provide service in the state of Missouri. Therefore, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel the above-mentioned certificate.

5. The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests a hearing.²

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully recommends the Commission cancel Convergia's Certificate of Service Authority to provide service in Missouri as discussed in the foregoing paragraphs.
