ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE AND DENYING MOTION

On March 6, 2026,¹ Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed the above-referenced application.

The Commission directed notice and set a deadline for applications to intervene. On March 20, Consumers Council of Missouri (Consumers Council) filed a timely application to intervene. Consumers Council's intervention application also contained a motion to require Spire to follow Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135, which, for any information designated as confidential, requires the filing of a cover sheet or pleading describing how such information qualifies as confidential under the rule, including the specific subsection relied upon and an explanation of its applicability.

On March 23, Spire filed a response to Consumer Council's pleading in which it did not oppose the application to intervene. No other parties filed a response to Consumer Council's intervention application.

After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that Consumers Council has an interest that is different from that of the general public and allowing it to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

Spire's March 23rd response also addressed Consumer Council's motion regarding the confidential designation of the application, stating:

Spire Missouri marked its Application confidential pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.135(2)(A) 3 and 4 as it relates to marketing analysis or other market-specific information. This Application also contains material nonpublic information, the disclosure of which is governed and restricted by Regulation FD, specifically 17 CFR Sec. 243.100.

The Commission finds that, while Spire's application filed on March 6 did not meet the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135, in its March 23rd filing, Spire provided information that satisfies the intent of the rule. Therefore, the Commission will deny Consumer Council's motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application to intervene of Consumers Council of Missouri is granted.
2. The motion to require Spire to follow Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.135 is denied.
3. This order is effective when issued.

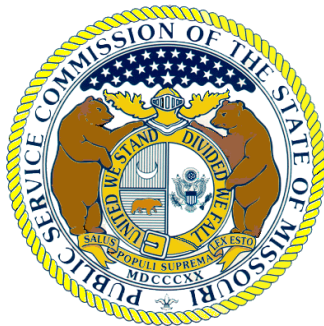
