**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and on behalf of itself, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”), the City of Neosho (“Neosho”), and the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”), respectfully submits this *Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule*:

2. Parties respectfully request that the hearing transcripts be expedited, if feasible, and made available to the parties by Monday, June 15, 2026.

Parties also respectfully request that the Commission include a provision in its order setting the procedural schedule that data requests sent after 1:00 pm on a Friday, or on a weekend or state/federal holiday will be considered served on the next business day. If the deadline for responses or objection/notification does not land on a business day, these items will not be due until the next business day. The parties to this case agree that this paragraph has no effect on the filing of testimony in this case.
