Today we replaced two of the relays that may have been problematic, and we hung an extra ground on the relays to ensure that they weren't losing their ground reference. I'm told that there is a good chance that we will be pumping back again today during the daywatch. Given the volatile market prices and the fact that today is a "red" day, my plan is to monitor the pump during today's start and also during tonight's on the PM/OWL. Provided everything works as designed on those two starts, I think we've got to call it good for now.
