**THE OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC COUNSEL’S RESPONSE TO MOTION**

**COMES NOW** the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC” or “Public Counsel”) and for its *Response to Motion*, states as follows:

1. The OPC would like to thank Mr. Brett Felber and Ms. Lisa Lambert (“Complainants”) for their *Motion Requesting Notice to and Participation by the Office of the Public Counsel*.
2. The OPC receives notice of all complaints filed with the Public Service Commission and was previously aware of this Complaint. The OPC has reviewed all filings and is currently awaiting the results of the investigation currently being conducted by the Public Service Commission’s Staff.
3. Section 386.710.1(2), RSMo states, “The public counsel shall have the following powers and duties . . . He may represent and protect the interests of the public in any proceeding before or appeal from the public service commission[.]” While the OPC cannot represent the interests of any individual complainant, it does

have the discretion to advocate on behalf of the general public in all cases that come before the Public Service Commission. In *pro se* complaints such as this one, the OPC looks for issues that may affect the public generally, such as a misinterpretation of a tariff or rule, and where it believes such misinterpretation has occurred, advocates for the public accordingly.

4. Therefore, Public Counsel would like to inform Complainants that it is keeping up to date with all aspects of this case and to the extent necessary to protect the interests of the public, may file a response after the release of the Public Service Commission Staff's investigation and the filing of its *Staff Recommendation*.

WHEREFORE, the OPC respectfully requests the Commission accept this response to Complainants' motion.
