

Dear Resident:

As a private-owned, regulated water and wastewater utility in the state of Missouri, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company works closely with the Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) when applying for approval to acquire an existing system.

We are currently applying for Certificates of Convenience and Necessity associated with the potential purchase of the sewer system assets (Baring, Hurdland, and Newark) of Consolidated Public Water Supply District No. 1 of Knox County. Our proposed monthly flat rate is \$35 dollars and, in addition, the Company will apply Confluence Rivers' existing service charges for these systems, subject to Commission approval.
