Good morning, Tyler.

I appreciate your responses and have the following comments...

1. The District would appreciate the drawings being updated to show their 100' easement. That way they are sure everyone is on the same page.
2. Vertical construction is any construction built above existing grade (i.e roads, fill, ect...) within the 100' easement. It does not appear that there is any vertical construction for this project, but the District wanted it to be clear, in the future, that this would not be allowed.
3. The flap gates that you have specified are acceptable to the Drainage District.

Finally, the Drainage District would like to inform Ameren that during the next ditch cleanout, the district will be placing spoils from the cleanout within their 100' easement. This will more than likely include placing material onto an existing service road adjacent to an existing substation next to the Sikeston Power Station that was recently constructed in the last couple years. Please see the attached drawing below.

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Tyler,

I am contacting you on behalf of the Richland Drainage District. I have reviewed your plans and have the following comment/questions:

1. Does the property line you have shown indicate the districts boundary? Does that boundary pertain to the 100' easement from the drainage Ditch Centerline and can we show that on the plans? We could not find it on any of the drawings provided. **The property line is 100' from the ditch centerline so I would propose this is in direct relation to the 100' easement.**
2. The District would like you to be aware that no vertical construction should occur within the Drainage District easements. **Can you further clarify vertical construction? We are not planning any infrastructure within the District's easement other than the storm sewer pipe. After excavation for the pipe is complete, the grades will be returned to the existing condition along with seed and straw to stabilize.**
3. The District wants to ensure that there is a minimum 18' wide driving lane width at the top of the levee for any cuts made through the levee. **We can confirm that the existing drive lane will remain after the pipe installation is complete.**
4. The District would like to have flap gates installed at the ends of each outfall that are within the drainage ditch. **We have specified 24" Waterman F10 flapgates (or approved equal). I have attached a cut sheet. Does this align with the District's intent?**
