NOTICE OF FORENSIC ANALYSIS AND EXAMINATION

I. RETENTION OF FORENSIC CONSULTANT

Complainants have formally retained Hypercore Wireless Consultants Corporation (“Hypercore”) to conduct a comprehensive forensic analysis and examination of all documents, records, audio, video, and electronically stored information associated with this proceeding.

Hypercore has been instructed to evaluate, authenticate, and analyze all filings, materials from Ameren Missouri, metadata, logs, and supporting documentation. Hypercore does not enter an appearance.

II. AUTHORITY FOR FORENSIC ENGAGEMENT

Supported by Missouri Revised Statutes § 536.070, § 386.410, 20 CSR 4240-2.130, and 20 CSR 4240-2.090, and general due process rights allowing expert retention.

III. FORENSIC SCOPE

Includes authentication, metadata validation, chain-of-custody analysis, alteration detection, email analysis, reconstruction, and comparative review.

IV. RESPONDENT CONCERNS

Demand issued April 8, 2026; response April 17, 2026. Materials are incomplete and lack identifiers, raising reliability and integrity concerns.

V. CORPORATE STATUS

Hypercore established 2024, Missouri-based, in good standing.

VI. SPECIALTIES

Digital forensics, telecom analysis, metadata recovery, document authentication, network analysis, audio/video forensics, fraud detection, regulatory review.

VII. RESERVATION OF RIGHTS

Complainants reserve all rights to challenge evidence and submit findings.
