I. INTRODUCTION

Hypercore Wireless Consultants Corporation (“Hypercore”) submits this continued forensic analysis in support of Complainants’ Motion to Strike, or in the alternative, to accord no evidentiary weight to Ameren Missouri’s Exhibit I-C.

II. SUPPLEMENTAL FORENSIC FINDINGS

A forensic review of Exhibit I-C reveals that the notarization was not performed by an independent third-party notary, but instead by Susan Toepper, an employee of Ameren Missouri.

III. DEFECTIVE NOTARIZATION AND AUTHENTICATION ISSUES

The use of an internal employee as a notary raises concerns including lack of independence, institutional bias, and absence of a custodial chain affidavit.

IV. COMPARATIVE AUTHENTICATION RELIABILITY

Complainant’s affidavit was notarized by an independent Notary Public in Harris County, Texas, enhancing credibility and neutrality.

V. CONCLUSION

Exhibit I-C should be stricken or accorded no evidentiary weight.
