**ORDER DIRECTING JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On November 5, 2025, in Case No. GA-2026-0121, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain, and otherwise control and manage equipment and facilities for the production, processing, pipeline interconnection, and distribution of renewable natural gas (RNG) in the Kansas City, Missouri area. Concurrently, in Case No. GO-2026-0122, Spire filed an application for approval of a RNG program, pursuant to Section 386.895, RSMo. In both applications, Spire requested a waiver of the Commission’s rule requiring 60 days’ notice prior to filing an application.<sup>1</sup>

In each case, the Commission set a deadline for entities to intervene and directed the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to review the application and file a recommendation.

On March 23, 2026, Staff filed its *Staff Recommendation*, covering both cases, in which it recommended the Commission deny the applications. On April 2, 2026, Spire filed

its *Response to Staff Recommendation*, expressing its disagreement with Staff's recommendation.

The Commission will direct the parties to collaborate on a joint proposed procedural schedule to be filed by Staff.

In addition, Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) permits the consolidation of pending actions that involve related questions of law or fact. As it appears that the cases involve common facts, parties, and issues, the Commission will inquire as to whether any party objects to the consolidation of these cases.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. No later than May 7, 2026, Staff shall file a joint proposed procedural schedule on behalf of all parties.
2. Any objections to the consolidation of Case Nos. GA-2026-0121 and GO-2026-0122 shall be filed no later than May 7, 2026.
3. This order is effective when issued.
