**MAWC’S COMPLIANCE FILING REGARDING  
ITS DROUGHT MANAGEMENT PLANS**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC” or “Company”), and states the following to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in support of *MAWC’s Compliance Filing Regarding Its Drought Management Plans*:

1. In the Commission’s Report and Order in this matter, the Commission incorporated a Partial Stipulation and Agreement, which included the following provision:

13. **Drought Management Plans:** The Signatories agree the Company shall continue to review for drought risk and resiliency as a component of longer-term planning for all of its water service areas. The Company shall file a report in this case that includes a description of any notable risks identified and any mitigation measures for all plans and water service areas within 12 months after the effective date of new rates resulting from this case. The Company shall ensure that any emergency contact information provided to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources is up to date.

2. In compliance with that provision, MAWC provides the following information in Appendix A, which summarizes the source waters for each production facility within Missouri American Water’s service areas.<sup>1</sup> The Trigger Event is the identified cause of low source water, which is primarily drought of record, with the exception of the Missouri River, which is a managed river. 4. As further required by the above provision, MAWC states that its emergency contact information provided to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources was updated as of February 2026, and, going forward, the Company plans to review and update this information as necessary on an annual basis.

**WHEREFORE**, MAWC prays the Commission accept this Compliance Filing 's requests and that the Commission issue such further orders as it should find to be reasonable and just.
