We appreciate the value you bring to customers through your participation in KCP&L's Business Energy Efficiency Rebates Program. Your commitment to help customers achieve higher annual energy savings is a cornerstone of the Program's long-term success and growing your company's bottom line. To continue providing a sustainable energy efficiency rebate program. we would like to make you aware of some adjustments to our program offerings.

- 1. Effective July 1, 2015. all Custom lighting and non-lighting rebates will be awarded on a per kWh energy savings at a flat rate structure. These projects will receive \$0.10 per kWh saved up to 50% of the project cost. Example: 150,000 kWh energy savings=\$15,000 rebate incentive.
- 2. Rebate offerings for Standard lighting. HVAC and additional measures remain unchanged for 2015.
- 3. The annual incentive cap per customer remains unchanged for 2015.

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KCP&L BUSINESS ENERGY EFFICIENCY REBATES PROGRAM CHANGES FAQs

Why are these changes taking place?

Changes are taking place to create long-term program sustainability and provide transparency in how rebates are

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calculated. These changes are a result of customer-driven feedback to simplify the participation process and align life cycle cost savings with rebates that are provided. ensuring KCP&L provides a cost-effective program for the marketplace.

What do these changes mean for my current projects already pre-approved?

Preapproval applications received prior to July 1, 2015 would qualify for the incentive rate established at the time the completed application was received.

What does this mean for future Custom rebate submissions?

Pre-approval project applications submitted with all required documentation **prior to July 1, 2015** qualify for the rebate amount prior to this change. Pre-approval applications and submissions received **after July 1, 2015** follow the revised program rebate amounts.

What if I miss the July 1, 2015, completed application deadline?

If your application is submitted and/or incomplete after July 1. 2015. your project receives rebate incentives at a flat rate of \$0.10 per kWh saved for lighting and non-lighting projects.

Will I receive a smaller rebate amount because of the changes?

The percentage of total project cost covered by the Business Energy Efficiency Rebate program decreases. However, because rebates are awarded based on kWh savings, you receive a higher rebate amount when you maximize your kWh savings.

What defines a complete application?

The pre-approval application must be completed in full with all required documentation as detailed in the "Required Documentation" section at the bottom of Page 1.

Exceptions may include:

- · Valid customer account number in lieu of customer electric bill
- Pre-approval application Section 5. Page 3 may be left blank if you submit a lighting inventory worksheet in the original Microsoft Excel format.
