Preferred Long Distance, Inc. ("Preferred") requests withdrawal of its Missouri Switched Exchange Access Tariff, Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 2, effective immediately.

Preferred's request is predicated on the Company's decision to cease intercarrier compensation – access charge - assessments to interconnecting carriers as part of its IP-enabled service transition, and in anticipation of the Federal Communications Commission's proposed elimination of intercarrier compensation.¹
