Medical Emergency Compliance: Respondents must disclose why disconnections were threatened or executed despite actual notice of Chronic Asthma and the residence of an infant, in direct violation of 20 CSR 4240-13.050(10). Emergency Stay: Under RSMo § 393.130, Complainant demands an immediate administrative stay of all disconnection activity and the restoration of any services terminated, as the cessation of utilities to a medically fragile household represents an immediate threat to life. IV. LEGAL BASIS The Commission has the power under RSMo § 393.140 to examine all accounts and records of utility corporations. Furthermore, under RSMo § 386.390, Complainant is entitled to a hearing on any act or omission by a public utility
