NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

Issue Date: May 20, 2026

On May 19, 2026, Kathy Archer filed a complaint with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri. The complaint requests that Ameren Missouri bury the electric lines on Ms. Archer’s property at Ameren Missouri’s expense.

Complaints against regulated utilities are governed by Section 386.390 RSMo (Supp. 2025) and Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.070. Among other filing requirements, the statute and rule require that complaints include an allegation that a utility violated a tariff, statute, rule, order, or Commission decision.

Ms. Archer’s pleading includes a requested remedy but does not appear to allege any violation of a tariff, statute, rule, order, or Commission decision by Ameren Missouri.¹ By not including an allegation of a violation, the complaint is deficient.

¹ The Commission’s complaint form includes a question regarding the facts of how the complained-of utility violated a statute, tariff, or Commission regulation or order. Ms. Archer’s complaint filing left this question blank.

The Commission cannot take action on Ms. Archer's filing until the deficiency is corrected. The Commission will leave this case open until June 22, 2026. If the deficiency is not corrected by that date, the Commission will reject the complaint filing and close the case.
