ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING

On April 17, 2026, Complainant filed complaints with the Commission against Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire. On April 21, 2026, Germany filed an additional complaint against Missouri American Water

Company. The Commission issued an order dismissing all of those complaints on May 7, 2026.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo, indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if “in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear.” In the judgment of the Commission, Complainant does not demonstrate sufficient reason to rehear the Commission’s order in any of those complaint cases.

Therefore, the Commission will deny Complainant’s application for rehearing or reconsideration.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Complainant’s request for rehearing or reconsideration is denied.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
