MOTION FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through counsel, and for its *Motion for Extension* states as follows:

1. On March 16, 2026, Complainant, Pernell Robinson, Jr. filed a Formal Complaint against Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire (“Spire”) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”).
2. On the same day, the Commission issued an order requiring Staff to conduct an investigation and file a report with the Commission on May 15, 2026.
3. On April 15, 2026, Spire filed a Motion for Summary Determination. In light of this motion, the Commission ordered Complainant and other parties wishing to respond to said motion to do so by May 15, 2026. Because the response deadline for the Motion for Summary Determination fell on the date originally designated for Staff’s report deadline, the Commission extended the filing deadline for Staff’s report to May 22, 2026.
4. Staff initially issued eight data requests (“DR”) in this investigation in mid-March. Upon further analysis of the complaint, Staff believed it necessary to issue additional DRs last week and this week.

5. Spire is working with Staff to provide responses to these DRs on an expedited timeline. However, in order that Staff may file a complete report, Staff respectfully requests the Commission extend the ordered filing date to June 18, 2026. Staff will endeavor to file the report before this date.

6. Staff informed Spire, the Office of the Public Counsel (“OPC”), and Complainant of Staff’s intent to request June 18, 2026, as the new filing date for the report; Spire and the OPC do not object. Complainant has not responded.

7. This motion is made in the interest of justice and without the intent to unreasonably delay these proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Motion for Extension* for the Commission’s consideration and prays the Commission grant further relief as it deems just and reasonable.
