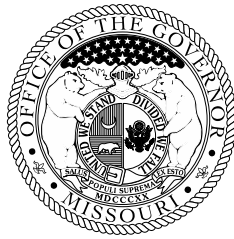

**PROPOSED AMENDMENT**

**20 CSR 4240-3.135 Filing Requirements and Schedule of Fees Applicable to Applications for Post-Annexation Assignment of Exclusive Service Territories and Determination of Compensation.** The Public Service Commission is amending the purpose section, sections (1) and (7), and subsection (1)(B).

*PURPOSE: This proposed amendment updates the rule citations in the rule from 4 CSR 240 to the current rule locations in 20 CSR 4240.*

*PURPOSE: This rule establishes the requirements that must be met and a schedule of fees for applications to the commission for post-annexation assignment of exclusive service territories and determination of compensation. As noted in the rule, additional requirements pertaining to such applications are set forth in [4 CSR 240-2.060(1)] **20 CSR 4240-2.060(1)**.*

(1) In addition to the requirements of [4 CSR 240-2.060(1)] **20 CSR 4240-2.060(1)**, municipally owned electric utility applications for post-annexation assignment of exclusive service territories and determination or compensation shall include:

(B) A specific designation of the proposed exclusive electric service territory boundary including maps showing the boundary and a schedule of the applicable Townships, Ranges, and Sections, by county. If the requested boundary cannot reliably be ascertained from the information supplied by the applicant, such applicant shall provide

additional information as requested by the commission or *[its staff]* **commission staff**, if necessary, including the legal description of the area;

(7) The parties shall be responsible for payment of any unpaid fees on and after the effective date of the commission's report and order relating to the application. The *[executive director]* **commission** shall send an itemized billing statement to the applicants on or after the effective date of the commission's report and order. Responsibility for payment of the fees shall be that of the parties to the proceeding as ordered by the commission in each case.
