MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) and for its *Motion to Consolidate* states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On May 28, 2026, MAWC filed applications seeking an order granting a redefinition of certain existing Certificates of Convenience and Necessity. The filing was made to comply with the *Partial Stipulation and Agreement* approved by the Commission in Case No. WR-2024-0320. MAWC agreed that within one year of the effective date of rates of that case, it would file new tariff service area maps and legal descriptions where necessary to define existing certificated area boundaries in a way that is consistent with Staff’s current preferences. The cases were assigned File Nos. WA-2026-0339 and SA-2026-0340.


2. In both cases, MAWC is the applicant, and in several locations the water and sewer territories involved overlap. Thus, the cases reference the same subject matter, will involve similar

parties, and will contain common questions of law and fact. Consolidation of File Nos. WA-2026-0339 and SA-2026-0340 would promote administrative efficiency for filings and discovery.

3. Previous cases of this nature have been consolidated for the ease of filings and discovery. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110 (3) allows the Commission to issue orders concerning pending cases to avoid unnecessary costs or delays if the actions involve related questions of law or fact. Thus, MAWC requests the Commission consolidate the above-captioned cases, designating WA-2026-0339 as the lead case.

WHEREFORE, MAWC requests the Commission issue an order consolidating File Nos. WA-2026-0339 and SA-2026-0340, designating File No. WA-2026-0339 as the lead case, and grant such further and other relief as is just and proper in the circumstances.
