

(C) A statement that the company will continue to comply with all applicable laws and rules relating to ETC designation;

(D) A statement that the company's contacts in EFIS have been reviewed and are correct; and

(E) A copy of the notice informing customers of the name change.

4. Staff has reviewed the notice for name change and found that KLM failed to include a statement of compliance with all applicable ETC rules and regulations, and failed to include a copy of the customer name change notice, as required by subsections (C) and (E), respectively.

5. Staff has notified KLM of the deficiencies in its notice and requested that KLM supplement the company's notice by submitting a filing remedying the deficiencies. However, as of the date of this filing, the company has not submitted the supplemental filing. Staff requests that the Commission order KLM to correct the deficiencies in its filing.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully submits this *Staff Notice* and requests that the Commission take notice of the deficiencies in the notice and direct KLM to file a supplemental filing correcting these deficiencies; and to grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just and reasonable in the circumstances.
