MOTION TO SUSPEND TARIFF AND EXTEND FILING DATE
FOR STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and respectfully states as follows:

1. On May 22, 2026, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”) filed revised tariff sheets to implement the terms of the *Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* (“Order”), issued by the Commission on October 23, 2024. The tariff sheets are assigned Tracking No. JE-2026-0145, with a requested effective date of June 21, 2026.

2. The Commission subsequently ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding the revised tariff sheets no later than June 8, 2026.

3. Within the transmittal letter, Ameren Missouri states that “The New Florence Energy Center is nearing completion and will satisfy the in-service criteria contained in Staff’s Recommendation (filed July 30, 2024) Memorandum pages 10-11, prior to the effective dates of these revisions.”¹

4. The in-service criteria were partially provided to Staff the afternoon of Wednesday, June 3, 2026; the remaining in-service criteria were provided by Ameren Missouri the morning of June 4, 2026.

5. Staff typically verifies that in-service criteria have been met prior to providing a recommendation regarding tariff changes impacted by said in-service criteria.

6. In addition to the need for review and verification of the in-service criteria, it appears the revised tariffs sheets do not include the following Commission ordered language in paragraph 13 of the Community Solar Program (“CSP”) Rider (missing language emphasized):

The Cost associated with any unsubscribed portion of the Program Resources will not be included in the revenue requirement used to establish base rates if subscriptions cover at least 50 percent of Program Resource. **The cost to the subscribers shall be the same as if the Program Resource was fully subscribed.** If subscriptions cover less than 50 percent of Program Resources, then the cost associated with the unsubscribed portion below 50 percent of Program Resources will be included in the revenue requirement used to establish base rates.²

7. To provide Staff the necessary time to review and verify the in-service criteria, conduct any additional discovery, ensure the agreed to language from the Commission’s Order is in the tariff, and provide its recommendation to the Commission, Staff requests that the Commission suspend the effective date of the revised tariff sheets filed under

Tracking No. JE-2026-0145, and issue an order directing Staff to file its recommendation in this matter no later than July 1, 2026.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests the Commission issue an order suspending the revised tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JE-2026-0145, directing Staff to file its recommendation in this matter no later than July 1, 2026, and any further relief deemed just and necessary under the circumstances.
