ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On May 14, 2026, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro filed the above-referenced application with the Commission seeking an order granting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct a 440 MW simple-cycle gas turbine electric generating facility. The Commission directed notice and set a deadline of May 29, 2026, for applications to intervene. On that date, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed timely applications to intervene. No parties objected to either intervention application in the ten days allowed for responses.¹

After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri and MECG have interests which are different from that of the general public and allowing them to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

1. The applications to intervene of Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) are granted.
