MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE JOINT PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), and for its Motion for Extension of Time to File Joint Procedural Schedule respectfully states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

1. On June 1, 2026, the Commission convened a procedural conference.
2. On June 3, 2026, the Commission ordered the filing of joint proposed procedural schedule no later than June 10, 2026.
3. Ameren Missouri, Co-Mo Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Co-Mo") and Mr. Eversole have agreed to continue discussions to determine whether this matter can be resolved without the need for an evidentiary hearing. To allow time for further discussions, Ameren Missouri requests an extension of time until June 30, 2026, to file a joint proposed procedural schedule.
4. The undersigned counsel has discussed this filing with Mr. Eversole, and counsel for the Staff of the Commission, the Office of Public Counsel, and Co-Mo, all of which have stated they do not oppose an extension until June 30, 2026, to allow further discussions.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri requests the Commission extend the time to file a joint procedural schedule from June 10, 2026, until June 30, 2026.
