ORDER DIRECTING FILING AND SETTING DEADLINE

Effective Date: April 16, 2021

On February 24, 2021,¹ the Commission issued its Order Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (Order) to Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC) to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system in an area of Stone County, Missouri (Table Rock Estates). As a condition of the Order, the Commission required MAWC to submit tariff sheets, to become effective before closing on the assets, to include a service area map and service area written description, to be included in its EFIS water tariff P.S.C. MO No 13 and water rates, applicable specifically to water service in its Table Rock service area.

On April 15, MAWC submitted Tariff Revision, tracking number YW-2021-0184, and advised the Commission that the compliance tariff sheets were being filed pursuant to and in conformity with the Order. The proposed tariff sheets bear an issue date of April 15 and an effective date of May 15. On April 15, MAWC also filed a Motion for Expedited Treatment advising the Commission that Table Rock Estates was prepared to close on April 30, and asking the Commission to allow the proposed tariff sheets to

become effective on less than thirty days' notice, to be effective on April 30. The Commission will order Staff to file a recommendation on an expedited basis and set a deadline for objections or responses to the proposed tariff sheets.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than April 19, 2021, the Commission Staff shall file a recommendation concerning MAWC's proposed Tariff Revision, tracking number YW-2021-0184.
2. Any party wishing to do so shall file a pleading regarding the proposed Tariff Revision, tracking number YW-2021-0184 no later than April 19, 2021.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
