## NOTICE OF HEARING AND COMMENT PERIOD

Issue Date: June 12, 2026

To be considered, comments must be received at the Commission's offices on or before **August 14, 2026**, and should include a reference to Commission Case No. TX-2026-0353. Comments may also be submitted via a filing using the Commission's electronic filing and information system (EFIS).

A public hearing regarding the proposed rule is scheduled for **August 20, 2026, at 10:00 a.m., in Room 310 of the Governor Office Building**, 200 Madison, Jefferson City, Missouri. Interested persons may appear at this hearing to submit additional comments and/or testimony in support of or in opposition to this proposed rule and may be asked to respond to Commission questions.
