COME NOW the Complainants, Aquila Canada and Dranel Clark, and respectfully move the Commission for an Order compelling Respondent Ameren Missouri to produce complete and accurate discovery.

I. BASIS FOR MOTION

1. Complainants have repeatedly requested:

- Full account audit
- Billing calculations
- Identification of software providers
- Explanation of billing discrepancies

2. Respondent has failed to provide:

- Complete responses

- Transparent documentation
- Verifiable billing methodology

## II. LEGAL AUTHORITY

This Motion is brought pursuant to:

- Missouri Revised Statutes § 393.140
- Missouri Public Service Commission procedural authority
- Applicable discovery enforcement principles

## III. FACTUAL GROUNDS

1. Billing increased from approximately \$█ to \$█ to \$█ within one billing cycle
2. No adequate explanation has been provided
3. Technician testimony confirms billing—not meter—issue
4. Respondent has attributed fault to unidentified third-party software

- Suspension of fees

- Any other relief deemed just and proper
