ORDER RECOGNIZING NAME CHANGE

Issue Date: June 15, 2026

Effective Date: June 25, 2026

On May 20, 2026, the Commission received a letter from N.W. Communication Co. d/b/a Fastwyre Broadband advising that it has;

- changed its corporate form from a corporation to a limited liability company;
- changed its name to N.W. Communication Co., LLC reflective of the changed corporate form; and
- changed its fictitious name to Socket Fiber.

N.W. Communication Co. was issued its basic local and non-switched local telecommunications service authority in Case No. CA-2022-0183.

On June 2, 2026, the Staff of the Commission filed its *Staff Notice*, stating that N.W. Communication Co. is designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) under Section 214(e)(1)-(2) of the Federal Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ to receive funds from the Federal Universal Service Fund. N.W. Communications Co. was granted its

ETC designation in Case No. CA-2023-0085. ETCs have additional name change requirements pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-31.015(2). The Commission ordered N.W. Communication Co. to supplement its application with the additional name change requirements, which it did on June 11, 2026

The Commission has reviewed the filings and Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-28.011(2) and 20 CSR 4240-31.015(2) and finds the company has complied with all statutory and regulatory requirements for changing its name. The Commission will recognize the name change.

The Commission finds it reasonable for this order to become effective in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission recognizes the name change of N.W. Communication Co. d/b/a Fastwyre Broadband to N.W. Communication Co., LLC d/b/a Socket Fiber.
2. This order shall become effective on June 25, 2026.
3. This case shall close on June 26, 2026.
