ORDER CANCELING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 30, 2020, Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application and tariff sheets seeking to establish an on-bill financing program and cost recovery mechanism. After suspension of the tariff sheets, the Commission set a procedural schedule including an evidentiary hearing. On April 20, 2021, Staff, on behalf of all the parties, filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule.

Staff relates that the parties are actively pursuing an agreement that will resolve all issues in this matter. Thus, Staff, on behalf of all the parties, requested that the procedural schedule be suspended to allow the parties time to finalize a settlement agreement.

The Commission finds the request reasonable and will cancel the current procedural schedule and direct the parties to file either a settlement agreement or a status report stating when they expect to file an agreement.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The procedural schedule, including the hearing set for June 17, 2021, is canceled.
2. No later than May 3, 2021, the parties shall file either their settlement agreement or a status report indicating when they expect to file the agreement.

3. This order is effective when issued.
