On April 29, 2026, the Commission issued a *Finding of Necessity and Order Directing Proposed Amendments 20 CSR 4240-40.020 and 20 CSR 4240-40.030 be Filed for Publication*. The proposed rule amendments were filed with the Secretary of State on April 30, 2026.
