RESPONSE TO STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (“Confluence Rivers”), and for its *Response to Staff Recommendation* states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”):

1. On April 10, 2026, Confluence Rivers filed an application seeking a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) and authority to acquire the sewer system assets of Mapaville Meadows #2, a nonprofit corporation that owns a wastewater treatment facility in Jefferson County, Missouri serving 12 homes.

2. On June 15, 2026, Staff filed its *Staff Recommendation* and supporting *Memorandum* suggesting that the Commission approve Confluence Rivers’ acquisition of the subject sewer system assets and issue a CCN, subject to 13 conditions described in Staff’s *Memorandum*.

3. Confluence Rivers has reviewed the proposed conditions listed on pages 21 and 22 of Staff’s *Memorandum* and has no objection to those proposed conditions.

WHEREFORE, Confluence Rivers requests the Commission issue an order approving Confluence Rivers’ *Application* and granting Confluence Rivers the CCN as recommended in Staff’s *Memorandum*, subject to the Staff conditions, and for such other and further relief as

deemed appropriate in the circumstances.
