**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING AN INTERVENTION DEADLINE, AND  
DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A PLEADING**

On June 23, 2026, Confluence Rivers Utility Operating Company, Inc. (Confluence Rivers) and Cannon Home Association, Inc., (Cannon Home) filed an application with the Commission requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) to acquire, own, install, construct, operate, control, manage and maintain a sewer system in Ralls County, Missouri. The requested CCN would allow Confluence Rivers to acquire the sewer system assets of Cannon Home.

Cannon Home operates a sewer system and provides sewer service to approximately 126 connections in Ralls County, Missouri. The connections consist of single-family homes, rental cabins, a restaurant, and a store. The facilities are open year-round. Confluence Rivers currently owns and operates a sewer system within three miles of Cannon Home. Both Confluence Rivers and Canon Home are regulated by the Commission

The application also requests a waiver of the 60-day notice requirement contained in Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

The Commission will direct that notice be given, set a deadline for intervention requests, and order its Staff to file a pleading.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Ralls County, Missouri, and the Missouri Department of Natural Resources.
2. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Division shall make notice of this order available to the media serving Ralls County, Missouri.
3. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than July 15, 2026.
4. No later than July 22, 2026, the Commission's Staff shall file a pleading indicating when it can file a recommendation regarding this application.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.
