



That motion was granted and Staff was ordered to submit its recommendation no later than June 29, 2026.

5. Staff is still awaiting additional discovery and information from Knox County regarding this transaction, and therefore, additional time to obtain and review the information is needed.

6. To provide sufficient time to conduct further discovery, analyze newly acquired data and information from both parties, and complete its investigation, Staff requests an additional 30 days in which to complete and file its report. That being said, Staff will endeavor to complete its review prior to any newly established filing date.

7. Counsel for Confluence Rivers has been contacted regarding this motion and does not object to the granting of an extension of time in this matter.

8. This Motion is made in the interest of justice and without the intent to unreasonably delay or hinder these proceedings in any manner.

**WHEREFORE**, Staff respectfully submits this *Second Motion for Extension of Time to File Staff Recommendation* for the Commission's information and consideration and hereby prays the Commission grant Staff an additional 30 days within which to file its report in this matter; and to grant such other and further relief as the Commission considers just and reasonable in the circumstances.
