On April 15, 2016, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed its 2016 Renewable Energy Standard Compliance Plan, as required by Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.100(8). Earth Island Institute, d/b/a Renew Missouri, United For Missouri, Inc., and the Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy have filed separate applications to intervene.

This is not a contested case, and stakeholders do not need to be parties to file comments as allowed by the Commission's regulation. However, unless they are made parties, the organizations that are seeking to intervene will not be able to view the highly confidential portions of the company's filings. Before ruling on the applications to intervene, the Commission will establish a shortened time for responses to those applications.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to respond to the applications to intervene filed by Renew Missouri, United for Missouri, or the Division of Energy, shall do so no later than April 22, 2016.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
