Please do not add any addition addendum to the requirements for the Licensed setup crews in our state. There are enough rules already on the books to manage and regulate the licensed crews that are setting homes in our state.

Specially the proposed requirement for regulating the installation and connection of the gas lines for homes built from factories with gas.

I have been a retailer in Missouri for over 25 years, and we do very little gas homes.

I feel the connections are better handled by professionals in our state that deal with natural gas and propane NOT the setup crews who are very unfamiliar with those types of connections.

I think this is adding undo responsibility and potentially dangerous outcomes if these connections are not done properly. We have had no problems explaining this to the consumers and making sure that proper licensed folks are doing these connections without incident.

I strongly oppose these requested changes.
