QUARTERLY UPDATE

Pursuant to the Missouri Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) order issued on February 6, 2026, in the above-captioned proceeding (“Wildfire Plan Order”),¹ ITC Midwest LLC (“ITC Midwest”) submits this quarterly update on the development of its wildfire mitigation and preparedness plan.

ITC Midwest is an independent, stand-alone transmission company engaged exclusively in the development, ownership and operation of facilities for the transmission of electric energy in interstate commerce. ITC Midwest is a subsidiary of ITC Holdings Corp. ITC Holdings Corp. invests exclusively in the electric power transmission grid to improve electric reliability, facilitate access to low-cost generation resources, improve access to power markets, and reduce the overall cost of delivered electric power. Transmission service over facilities developed and owned by ITC Midwest is provided by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc. (“MISO”) pursuant to its Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff. ITC Midwest owns transmission facilities in Missouri and is an electrical corporation.²

In the Wildfire Plan Order, the Commission directed electrical corporations to provide Commission Staff (1) a final draft copy of their wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans no later than December 31, 2026; and (2) quarterly updates on the development of their wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans, with the first update due no later than March 31, 2026. The Wildfire Plan Order included a series of minimum expectations and components that must be included in electrical corporations' wildfire mitigation and preparedness plans. ITC Midwest filed its first quarterly update with the Commission on March 30, 2026.

ITC Midwest is currently outlining its proposed compliance with each of the components included in the Wildfire Plan Order and compiling supporting information, after which ITC Midwest intends to begin preparing a wildfire mitigation and preparedness plan applicable to its facilities in Missouri that complies with the Wildfire Plan Order.
