## ORDER GRANTING APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

On June 9, 2026,<sup>1</sup> John Leuchtmann (Complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against Liberty Utilities, LLC d/b/a Liberty. On June 26, the Lakewood Hills Homeowners Association, Inc. (Lakewood Hills) filed its application to intervene. More than ten days have passed since the application was filed and no one has responded.<sup>2</sup>

After considering the unopposed application to intervene, the Commission finds that the applicant has interests which are different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the unopposed application to intervene.

### THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Lakewood Hills' application to intervene is granted.
