NOTICE OF INTENDED CASE FILING

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") under 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1) and gives notice that it will file an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") for a new transmission substation, rerouting of the existing transmission lines, and building a new line as follows:

1. 20 CSR 4240-20.045 contains the requirements for applications to obtain CCNs for electrical facilities.
2. The issues likely to be before the Missouri Public Service Commission in this case may be any issue related to the addition of a transmission substation, including siting, rerouting existing lines into the new substation, building a new line, Ameren Missouri's need for the project and finding the project is in the public interest.
3. Ameren Missouri has had no communications with the Office of the Commission (as defined in 20 CSR 4240-4.015(10)) respecting this filing during the 90 days prior to filing this notice.
