SIERRA CLUB'S APPLICATION TO INTERVENE

Sierra Club, pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.075, applies to intervene in this docket. In support of its application to intervene, Sierra Club states the following:

1. Sierra Club is a nonprofit organization organized and existing under the nonprofit corporation laws of the state of California. Sierra Club has more than 595,000 members nationally and more than 8,800 members in Missouri, many of whom reside in Ameren Missouri's service territory and are Ameren Missouri ratepayers. The Missouri Chapter of Sierra Club has an office at 725 Kingsland Ave, University City, MO 63130.

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3. Sierra Club exists for the purpose of preserving and protecting environmental values. Consistent with this mission, Sierra Club for many years has advocated for transitioning the electricity sector from coal-and gas-burning generation to cleaner and lower cost forms of energy, such as energy efficiency, renewable energy sources, and energy storage. Sierra Club's interest in protecting and enhancing the quality of ambient air and water throughout the state will be favorably affected if Ameren Missouri pursues renewable energy, energy efficiency, and demand response programs that displace fossil fuel generation. Sierra Club is concerned with emissions of greenhouse gases that cause climate change and with pollution from coal and gas that causes a host of health problems including asthma, mercury poisoning, sudden infant death syndrome, respiratory problems, and other issues.

4. Sierra Club has been a party to numerous Ameren Missouri general rate cases, as well as integrated resource planning, energy efficiency, vehicle electrification, and other proceedings.

5. Sierra Club's interest in promoting cleaner and lower-cost forms of energy is different from that of the general public and could be adversely affected by an order approving rate designs or a revenue requirement that disincentivizes energy efficiency, discourage renewable generation, or prolong reliance on coal-burning power plants. Sierra Club's intervention would serve the public interest in promoting prudent resource planning, public health, and the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions. Sierra Club's intervention would also serve the public interest because Sierra Club intends to conduct discovery on Ameren Missouri's requested rate increase and Sierra Club may file expert testimony, which would enhance the record for the Commission's final decision in this matter.

6. Sierra Club has not yet determined the positions it will take in this matter. Sierra

Club will likely explore the amount and justification for spending at the Labadie and Sioux coal-burning power plants. Sierra Club generally supports reasonable investments in renewable energy, energy efficiency, and demand response programs, and may take a position on these issues. Sierra Club also supports rate design that incentivizes conservation of energy, including through low fixed customers charges, and may investigate these issues.

7. It will serve the public interest for the Missouri Public Service Commission to grant this application to intervene.

WHEREFORE, Sierra Club respectfully requests the Public Service Commission to grant this application to intervene.
