ORDER OF CORRECTION

The Commission is correcting its *Order Setting Local Public Hearings*, issued July 14, 2026. This order is issued *nunc pro tunc* under Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.160(4), to correct Paragraph 3.

Paragraph 3 stated the following:

No later than three days before the local public hearings, Ameren Missouri shall provide notice of the hearings to each of its customers. For those customers who have consented to receive email and/or text message notifications, Ameren Missouri shall provide notice by such means.

The correction restates the notice requirements, as agreed to by the parties.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's *Order Setting Local Public Hearings*, issued July 14, 2026, is corrected *nunc pro tunc*, to revise Paragraph 3 to read as follows:

No later than three days prior to the local public hearings, Ameren Missouri shall provide notice to all Ameren Missouri customers by email and/or text message who have consented to receive such communication.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commissions of St. Louis, Audrain, Lincoln, and Stoddard Counties, to the Board of Alderman of the City of St. Louis, to the General Assembly members representing those counties and city, and to the news media serving those counties and city.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
