APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF AMAZON DATA SERVICES, INC.

Pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-2.075, Amazon Data Services, Inc. ("ADS") hereby files this Application to Intervene in the above matter and states the following:

1. On June 26, 2026, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted tariff sheets to produce a net increase in its electric base rates of approximately \$343 million.

2. On June 30, 2026, the Commission issued an Order Giving Notice, Setting a Deadline to Intervene, Setting a Deadline to Respond to the Test Year, and Directing a Proposed Schedule.

3. ADS seeks to intervene because the Commission's actions herein will affect ADS' interests.

4. Amazon Data Services, Inc. is a subsidiary of Amazon.com, Inc. and an affiliate of Amazon Web Services, Inc. (collectively "Amazon"). The principal office of Amazon Data Services, Inc. is 410 Terry Avenue North in Seattle, WA 98109-5210. The contact information for Amazon's attorney is set forth below.

5. ADS develops and operates data centers to support cloud computing services offered by Amazon Web Services. Amazon Web Services has the world's largest and most extensive global infrastructure and provides the world's most comprehensive and broadly adopted cloud computing services, offering over 240 fully featured services from data centers globally.

6. Within the last two years, Amazon has announced more than \$72 billion in planned infrastructure investments across multiple states such as Mississippi, Indiana, Ohio, Georgia, North Carolina, and Pennsylvania and is currently evaluating opportunities for further investments in additional states, like Missouri.¹

7. ADS has a unique interest in this docket to the extent this proceeding influences ratemaking principles applicable to large-load customers throughout the region.

8. On June 15, 2026, Amazon announced it will invest several billion dollars to build a new data center campus in Montgomery County, Missouri, a project expected to create more than 400 permanent jobs, thousands of construction jobs, and hundreds of millions of dollars in new tax revenue while funding more than \$7 million in local community improvements and infrastructure.²

9. ADS has an interest in this proceeding different from that of the general public and therefore meets the requirements of 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3)(A).

10. ADS does not yet have a position on the issues in this case and reserves the right to take positions on specific issues in this case after review of discovery and additional information to be adduced during the pendency of the proceeding.

11. ADS intervention will serve the public interest by assisting the development of the record for the Commission's decision in this case.
