ORDER APPROVING LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE LANGUAGE

On July 2, 2026,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Regarding Procedural Schedule*.

In Ordered Paragraph 13, the Commission ordered Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro to amend or delete the proposed notice language in Paragraph 11.c. of Evergy Missouri Metro's *Motion to Amend Order Setting Procedural Schedule Regarding Local Public Hearing* filed June 23, as it was outdated.

On July 2, Evergy Missouri Metro filed its *Response to Order* containing revised language it planned to provide to notify its customers of the virtual local public hearing scheduled for September 10.

On July 6, the Office of the Public Counsel (Public Counsel) filed its *Reply to Evergy Metro, Inc.'s Response to Order* (Reply). The Reply suggests that additional language be added that includes both the size and nature of the power generating plant and that Evergy Missouri Metro is seeking to recover construction work in progress before the plant is fully operational and used for service.

¹ Unless otherwise stated, all dates refer to the year 2026.

The Commission finds the additional language suggested by Public Counsel unnecessary and will approve the language set out in Every Missouri Metro's July 2nd *Response to Order*.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The language set out in *Every Missouri Metro's Response to Order* filed July 2, 2026, is approved for it to use in notices to its customers regarding the virtual local public hearing scheduled for September 10, 2026.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
