**STAFF RECOMMENDATION TO APPROVE
PROPOSED REVISED TARIFF SHEET**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and files its *Staff Recommendation to Approve Proposed Revised Tariff Sheet* in response to the Commission’s July 9, 2026, *Order Directing Filing (Order)*, and states as follows:

1. On April 20, 2026, Spire Missouri, Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application requesting a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CCN”) to construct, install, own, operate, maintain and other wise control and manage a natural gas distribution system in Christian County, Missouri, as an expansion of its existing certificated areas and requesting a waiver from the notice provisions of the Commission. Additionally, Spire requested a waiver of the Commission’s 60-day notice requirement under 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1).

2. On June 17, 2026, Staff filed its Staff Recommendation that the CCN should be granted subject to conditions set forth in its Staff Memorandum.

3. On June 19, 2026, Spire filed its Response to Staff’s Recommendation, wherein, it agreed to the recommendation as well as the conditions.

4. On July 8, 2026, the Commission granted Spire's Application for a CCN subject to the conditions, and ordered a revised tariff sheet be filed by Spire to include Section 03, Township 26 North, Range 21 West of Christian County (consisting of only Phase 1 and the potential eleven additional customers between the Company's existing facilities and Phase 1) as part of its certificated area.

5. On July 8, 2026, Spire filed a revised tariff sheet that includes the subject area of the CCN request, which would satisfy Staff's recommended condition. The revised tariff sheet had an effective date of August 7, 2026, and was assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0005.

6. On July 9, 2026, the Commission ordered Staff to file a recommendation regarding said tariff sheet no later than July 20, 2026.

7. Staff has reviewed the tariff sheet filed on July 8, 2026, with an issue date of July 8, 2026, and an effective date of August 7, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0005, and recommends the Commission approve or allow to go into effect for service as follows:

Fourth Revised Sheet No. 21.3, Cancelling Third Revised Sheet No. 21.3

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission approve Spire's updated tariff sheet as listed in paragraph 7 above, Tariff Tracking No. JG-2027-0005, with an effective date of August 7, 2026, or allow the same tariff sheet to go into effect by operation of law.

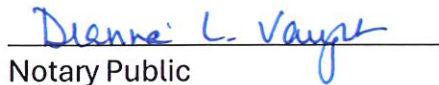
