customer service representative. CenturyTel is working toward a web-based solution that should allow for automation to the interconnecting companies. We anticipate this functionality to be available within nine months of the expected close date of the transaction.

In any event, it is not expected that this, or any other such deviation, will have a material impact on the interconnection/resale arrangements. As with the above-detected issue, a suitable procedure will be adopted in any other instance where a technical issue arises to ensure a performance level comparable to that offered by Verizon.

10 . Q. Would you please summarize your testimony?

Yes, not only will the sale of the assets not be detrimental to the public, it will be in the public interest. CenturyTel has the financial and operational expertise to own and operate the properties. In fact, the transfer will be a positive step because it matches a company that understands the rural nature of these exchanges with the customers to be served. CenturyTel has demonstrated its ability to operate newly-acquired properties through its acquisition of similar properties in Missouri in 2000. The transfer of these properties will accelerate the introduction of new products and services.
