ORDER RECOGNIZING CHANGE OF NAME Missouri Public

Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel (CenturyTel) filed a letter, an adoption notice tariff sheet and a revised title tariff sheet for its tariffs numbered 1-6 with the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) notifying the Commission of its intent to use the fictitious name, CenturyTel, on February 9, 2001. The effective date on the tariff sheets is March 12, 2001. CenturyTel included with its adoption notices a copy of its Fictitious Name Registration Application filed with the Missouri Secretary of State's office on February 5, 2001.

The Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation with an attached memorandum on February 23, 2001, stating that Staff had reviewed CenturyTel's request and, finding them satisfactory, recommended approval of the amended tariffs sheets. Staff stated that CenturyTel has met all of the requirements of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(16), and therefore, the Commission should approve the name change as reflected in the adoption notice tariff sheets and revised title sheets.

The Commission has reviewed the filings and finds that the name change should be recognized and the proposed adoption notice tariff sheets and revised title sheets should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- That the adopted name "Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel" is acknowledged.
 - That the adoption notice tariff sheets and revised title sheets

for tariffs 1-6, filed in Tariff File No. 200100821, by Spectra Communications Group, LLC, d/b/a CenturyTel, on February 9, 2001, are approved to become effective on March 12, 2001.

3. That this order shall become effective on March 11, 2001.
