Pursuant to the August 29, 2022, Order on Application for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity issued in Docket No. 22-NETE-419-COC ("Order"), NextEra Energy Transmission Southwest, LLC ("NEET Southwest") hereby submits the Annual Report for WCBB transmission line. Under the Order, the Annual Report must be filed in a "compliance docket." Accordingly, this letter has been filed in a new docket, for which a docket number has not yet been assigned.

The WCBB transmission line was energized on July 15, 2025. Accordingly, this report covers a one-year reporting period from July 15, 2025 to July 15, 2026.

This report includes the following items, as required by the Order:

2. Transmission line maintenance activities and inspections completed and respective inspection results
