ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

On July 15, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Compliance Tariff Sheets* (Order). That order approved several tariff sheets to become effective on August 3, 2026, including 13th Revised Sheet No. 17q, which addresses Liberty’s Fuel Adjustment Clause (FAC).

However, in Liberty’s FAC and True-Up cases, Case Nos. ER-2026-0260 and EO-2026-0261, the Commission approved 12th Revised Sheet No. 17q to become effective on June 1, 2026. The 12th Revised Sheet No. 17q is meant to stay in effect until December 1, 2026.

Therefore, the Order’s approval of 13th Revised Sheet No. 17q inadvertently superseded the 12th Revised Sheet No. 17q before the latter had completed its intended term.

The Commission’s decision in the general rate case was to continue Liberty’s existing FAC rates, subject to certain adjustments reflected in agreements attached to and incorporated into the Commission’s order. Those adjustments did not alter the currently effective FAC rate elements set forth in 12th Revised Tariff Sheet 17q.

Because the Order inadvertently caused the 13th Revised Sheet No. 17q to become effective before the expiration of the 12th Revised Sheet No. 17q, the Commission will correct its Order *nunc pro tunc*.

This Order Nunc Pro Tunc corrects ordered paragraph number 1 of the Order.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Order Approving Compliance Tariff Sheets*, issued by the Commission on July 15, 2026, is corrected *nunc pro tunc* so that ordered paragraph number 1 reads “The proposed tariff sheets assigned Tracking No. JE-2026-0123, filed on March 6, 2026, and as substituted on June 18, 2026, with the exception of 13th Revised Sheet No. 17q, are approved to become effective on August 3, 2026. 13th Revised Sheet No. 17q is rejected.”.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
