ORDER SETTING ADDITIONAL LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

The Commission, for good cause and on its own motion, will set an additional in-person local public hearing in this case to take place in Moscow Mills, Missouri.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall make an informal presentation and conduct a question-and-answer session for the public at the beginning of the local public hearing. Comments to the Commission from the public will begin at the conclusion of the question-and-answer session.
2. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri, the Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel shall make a representative available to address substantive issues during the question-and-answer session. Any other party may also choose to have a representative present.
3. No later than five days prior to the local public hearing, Ameren Missouri shall provide notice to all Ameren Missouri customers by email and/or text message who have consented to receive such communication.

4. The Commission's Data Center shall provide a copy of this order to the County Commission of Lincoln County, to the General Assembly members representing Lincoln County, and to the news media serving Lincoln County.

5. An in-person local public hearing shall be held as follows:

6. Testimony at the hearing may be limited to allow everyone the opportunity to testify. Priority will be given to persons who have not testified at the previous local public hearings held in this case.
