ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO STRIKE CERTAIN EXHIBITS

On August 1, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed objections and a motion to strike certain documents presented to the Commission by lay witnesses at the local public hearings. Ameren Missouri also moved the Commission to modify the procedural schedule to allow for the filing of surrebuttal testimony and to delay the evidentiary hearing by approximately three weeks. On August 2, the Commission directed the parties to respond to the proposal to modify the procedural schedule by August 7. Staff and Labadie Environmental Organization/Sierra Club filed such responses on August 7.

The Commission's August 7 order did not address the time allowed for filing of a response to Ameren Missouri's motion to strike specific exhibits. Under the Commission's general rule on responding to filings, such a response would be due on August 12, ten days after the motion was filed.¹

In its response to the motion to modify the procedural schedule, Labadie Environmental Organization/Sierra Club asked that it be allowed until August 19 to file a

response to the motion to strike specific exhibits. Given the extent of the motion filed by Ameren Missouri, the Commission finds that the request for additional time to respond is reasonable. The Commission will extend the time for filing a response.

The Commission will address the proposed modification of the procedural schedule in a separate order.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Objections and Motion to Strike Certain Exhibits, as described in the body of this order, shall do so no later than August 19, 2013.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
