ORDER MODIFYING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 26, 2015, the Commission issued an order modifying the procedural schedule in this matter ("March 26 Order"). In the March 26 Order, the Commission set the evidentiary hearing in this matter for April 8-10 and 13-17, 2015. Since the March 26 Order, the parties have submitted a non-unanimous stipulation and agreement and a *Second Agreement Regarding Cross Examination and Admission of Testimony, Request for Witnesses to Be Excused, and Motion to Modify Hearing Schedule*. The Commission held a pre-hearing conference on April 7. Based on the pre-hearing conference, the Commission will revise the evidentiary hearing schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Evidentiary Hearing shall be held on April 14 through April 17, 2015 beginning at 10:00 a.m. at the Commission's office at the Governor Office Building, Room 310. This building meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
